

Réka Szabó

Hungarian soprano, Réka Szabó, began her artistic career with singing studies in Budapest and gained nationwide recognition through the TV show "Virtuózok." After completing her studies at the Opera Studio Biel in Switzerland, she performed at prestigious venues such as the Bühnen Bern, Luzerner Theater, and the Palais de Beaulieu in Lausanne.

She portrayed various roles, including Adele (Die Fledermaus), Jano (Jenůfa), and Berta (Il Barbiere di Siviglia). Since 2022, she has been leading her own opera festival in Zsámbék. In September 2023, Szabó Réka began her studies in Cultural Management at the University of Basel. As an expert in music theater productions, she realized projects such as the Opera Festivals in Schärding/Zsámbék (musical theater performance), "Ich verstehe dich nicht" (song recital), "Kurzes leben, langes Sterben" (song recital), and many more. The latter projects increasingly explored the use of Artificial Intelligence technologies on stage. In 2023 October she began her Kulturmanagement studies at the Basel University.

Since January 2024, she has been working as a manager at the agency TOURBO in Zurich and at the FESTIVAL STRINGS LUCERNE, broadening her horizons.
